## 1. Convocation planning

Senators Cat Stylinksi and Elizabeth North have designed a Convocation centered on Science Communication and Engagement. Supported by Center Administration, the first day is centered on a 2-hour expert participatory presentation by Mr. Brian Palermo who has addressed ASLO and other groups on the subject of using acting techniques (improvisation) to more effectively communicate science to the public.
