The award is presented annually at a spring ceremony.

Required Nomination Materials:

- ☐ At least one letter of support from a community partner, participant, or someone else able to speak to the nominee's STEM activities and eligibility for the award. Letters of support are of particular interest to the selection committee.
- Other supporting documentation such as program/event flyers, photos, news articles, or other materials that support your nomination.

Nomination Process:

The nomination period is open from November to December. To nominate an individual or organization, complete an online nomination form at www.umces.edu/al/inspiration-award.

Eligibility:

- ☐ Both individuals and organizations (private, public, or non-governmental) are eligible.
