## IMET SUMMER INTERNSHIP

- The mission of the Institute of Marine and Environmental Technology (IMET) is to apply the tools of modern biology and biotechnology to study, protect and enhance marine and estuarine resources. The summer internship will provide orientation to working in a lab, seminars on the use of molecular techniques in fisheries and environmental research, a one-day workshop on communicating science, and a research project with an IMET faculty mentor.
- We plan to have in-person internships at IMET's laboratories at the Inner Harbor in Baltimore, MD. If extenuating circumstances prevent us from hosting in-person interns in the summer of 2023, we will do our best to adjust and will inform our applicants of any changes.
- The duration of the internship is Monday, June 5 through Friday, August 4, 2023. It is a **full-time position. Please do not apply if you can only be here for part of the specified time, have another job or are attending classes during the day.** Final reports will be presented on Friday, August 4.
- You are expected to participate fully in the daily operation of the laboratory to which you are assigned, attend lab meetings, professional development sessions, posted seminars, and conduct research as outlined by your mentor. Evenings and weekends may be required.
- IMET intends to provide summer housing for students from outside the Baltimore metropolitan area. If you need housing, please respond "No" to the residence question on page 2.
- This internship is most applicable to undergraduate students studying biology, marine science, environmental science, and other related degrees. (Preference will be given to rising juniors and seniors.) Students from educational backgrounds with limited access to research opportunities and students from underserved communities with an interest in marine science and environmental science are welcomed and encouraged to apply.
- Interns will comply with all COVID-19 procedures in place at IMET throughout the duration of the internship.
